He is also the Vice-President of the Chinese Forbidden City Society. Professor Yan initiated and helped to establish the Beijing Social Sciences Institute, the Beijing Manchuria Research Institute, Beijing Manchu Research foundation (the first official academic institution that focused on the Manchu history). He is also one of the few highly in demand speakers on China's national television platform (China Central Television, a State-owned Enterprise) in the popular series known as "Lecture Room" (百家讲坛).
